Membership Pledge

- P As a garden member I pledge to abide by the rules of the Kelmscott Community Garden Inc.
- P I understand that membership will commence on receipt of membership fee. Membership will lapse 12 months from that date, at which time I must reapply.
- P I will participate in a minimum of 2 busy bees (or work for a recognised equivalent amount of time in the garden) during the first 6 months of my membership in order to qualify for a share of the communal garden produce, as determined by the Committee. This may vary depending on the type of produce and the success of crops.
- P I understand that some communal garden produce may be sold (unprocessed or processed) by the KCG to the public in order to raise funds for the garden. I will be entitled to purchase this produce from the KCG at reduced rates to the general public.
- P I will not interfere with the rights and opportunities of others using the garden.
- P I understand that my participation at the garden is at my own risk. The KCG is not liable for any injury to members or others invited by members on site, nor for the loss of any possessions.
- P I will be responsible for the supervision of any children I bring to the garden.
- P I will abide by the agreed gardening principles of the KCG as determined by the Committee.
- P I will leave the garden neat and tidy and dispose of rubbish in a responsible manner.
- P I will always be aware of the safety of others and myself.
- P I will be responsible for the supervision of any dogs I bring to the site, keep them on a lead, ensure they do not cause any stress for others at the garden, scoop up any droppings and dispose of them off the garden site.
- P I will not divulge the combination lock code to any non-members and I shall report any suspicious activity to a member of the Committee.
- P I will keep the Committee updated with any changes in contact details.
